POSITION SUMMARY

The Asphalt QC Technician is responsible for daily asphalt testing and communicating with responsible personnel at our asphalt plants and jobsites to ensure adherence to federal, state, and/or customer specifications.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Perform asphalt testing and analysis at asphalt plants and jobsites.
- Perform volumetric testing for multiple mixes utilized on a daily basis.
- Perform (nuclear gauge) testing on asphalt pavements.
- Extract field core samples; prepare and test in the lab.
- Deliver samples to appropriate agencies.
- Communicate effectively and efficiently with agencies, plants, and site personnel.
- Submit daily production reports utilizing appropriate software or diary records.
- Perform service, repair, and calibration of laboratory and field-testing equipment on a timely basis.
- Maintain the lab in a neat and professional manner.
- Adhere to all safety policies and procedures.

- HS diploma or equivalent (GED) with a minimum of 2 years' experience in an asphalt QC role required.
- Willingness to join the applicable trade union, as required for this position.
- Excellent communication skills, both written and oral.

- Ability to perform effectively under pressure and get along well with others.
- Strong organizational skills with focus on prioritization of workload.
- Experience with asphalt lab equipment.
